Meeting Minutes

March 6th, 1959

The tenth meeting of the Executive in 1959 was held on Friday, March 6, at 12:35 in the Executive Room with President Carl Christiansen in the chair.

1. Moved Mike Tindall and seconded John Sutton that the minutes be adopted as corrected. Carried
2. "Baby Doll"—censored version only available—either find cuts or play And God Created Women—B.C. could be booked now for next year, but Warner Brothers must be told that we will play only the uncensored version.
3. Vancouver Film Festival—although we could get up to \$400, we shall keep the rental to \$300.
4. Banquet—list is up to be signed, after-party possibly at Barb Bennett's, programmed being printed.
5. Reel Award—Moved Bryan Isbister and seconded Lynn Warner that the decision on who shall receive the Reel Award be made by the previous recipient and the president. Defeated
with Lynn Warner and Bryan Isbister abstaining.

Moved Bryan Isbister and seconded Brian McMorran that the movement be amended to read: The decision on who shall receive the Reel Award be made jointly by the President and the previous recipient with the President to have the deciding word but the presentation shall be made by the previous recipient. Defeated
with Lynn Warner abstaining.

Moved Harry Adderley that the Reel Award presentation be the sole decision of the previous recipient or his delegate. Seconded Dick Drysdale. Carried
with Bryan Isbister dissenting and Lynn Warner abstaining.

6. Moved Brian McMorran and seconded Dick Drysdale that Brian McMorran and Barbara Bennett make an advertising film for next year's Clubs Day to be completed within first week of registration, to be made chiefly in the summer, length to be the maximum of 5 minutes. Carried

Moved Brian McMorran and seconded Mike Tindall that the previous motion be amended to read as before, with the additional clause: that we spend not over \$110.

7. Moved Bryan Isbister and seconded Mike Tindall that the meeting be adjourned.
